GDPR

We will always comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) when dealing with your personal data.

This PPSA website is hosted on wix.com, which provides us with an online platform that allows us to deliver content and sailing-related links and events that you can enter. Data will be stored through Wix.com data storage databases and general applications. They store the data on secure servers behind a firewall.

Payments gateways

All payment gateways offered by wix.com and used by the PPSA adhere to the standards set by PCI-DSS. Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards. Managed by the PCI Security Standards Council, which offers you the opportunity to pay by for example, with a Visa or MasterCard, etc.

Refunds for events

- PPSA does not offer a refund for racing events, either in person or online.

Your annual membership

- Your membership will commence when payment is received in April.
- Unless terminated earlier in accordance with the terms of the agreement, it will remain in force for a period of 12 calendar months
- Membership fee is paid in full on the last day of April.

How We Safeguard Your Personal Information

We will not share your personal information outside the UK without your permission. We have adopted industry-standard technology and operational security measures to protect your personal data from loss, misuse, unauthorized alteration, or destruction. Please be aware that while we strive for maximum security, information transmitted over the internet cannot be guaranteed to be 100% secure. For any online payments, we utilize a recognized secure payment system as outlined in our terms and conditions. In the event of a breach that may pose a serious risk to your personal data, we will notify you promptly.

Who else has access to the information you provide us?

Your personal data will never be sold. will not share your personal information with any third parties without your prior consent, which you are free to deny, except when legally required or as outlined in the table above.

We may share your personal data with third-party service providers, agents, and subcontractors to assist in tasks and services (like news items and sending mailings). This is done to support our legitimate interests and fulfill our contract with you, sharing only necessary data. We ensure these parties keep your information secure and do not use it for their own purposes, and if they engage sub-processors, similar contractual safeguards apply.

We may share your data with the RYA for legitimate survey purposes. They may use third parties but will only disclose necessary data, ensuring security and proper use.

How long do we keep your information?

We will keep your personal data while you are a member and as long as necessary for our legal obligations. We will review it annually to confirm our processing rights. We securely destroy all financial information once we have used it and no longer need it.

Your rights: You have rights under the GDPR:

- to access your personal data
- to be provided with information about how your personal data is processed
- to have your personal data corrected
- to have your personal data erased in certain circumstances
- to object to or restrict how your personal data is processed
- to have your personal data transferred to yourself or to another business in certain circumstances.
